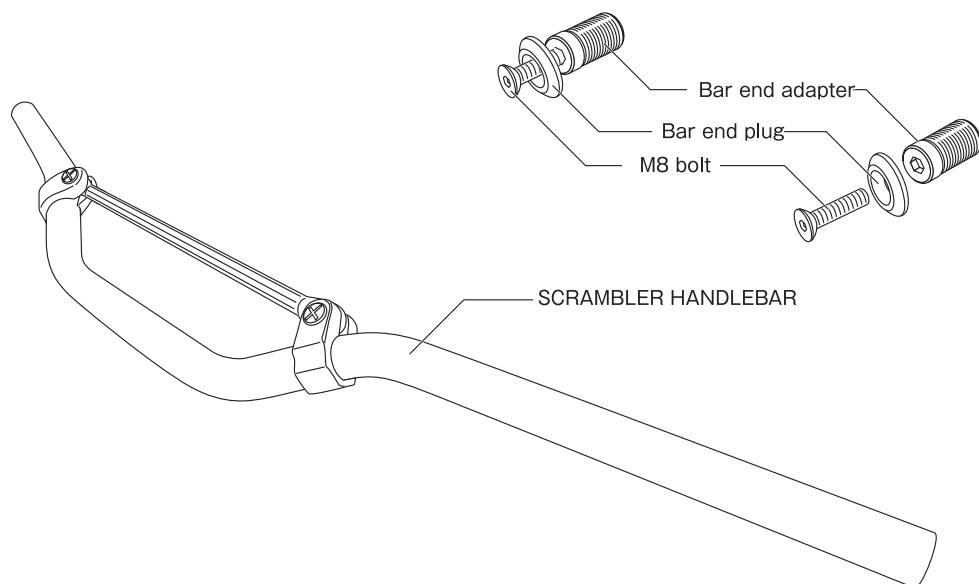
ZETA SCRAMBLER HANDLEBAR GB350/S

3.Installation

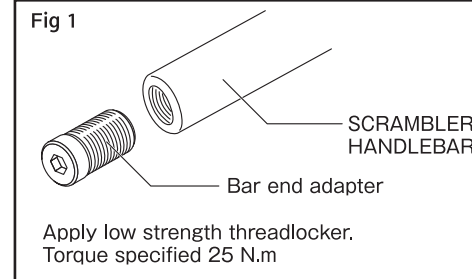
- 1) Remove each lever, switch box, etc., referring to the service manual, and remove the stock handlebar.

*For smooth removal of the throttle, loosen the throttle housing bolts without disassembling the throttle, and remove the throttle and handlebar at the same time.

- 2) Install the SCRAMBLER HANDLEBAR on the bike and assemble it to the preferred angle.

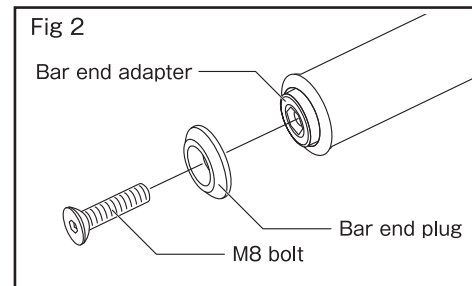
*It is recommended to insert the throttle tube/throttle housing into the handlebars first before assembling the handlebars to the bike for smooth operation.

- 3) Attach the bar end adapter to the SCRAMBLER HANDLEBAR (Fig 1). Refer to the service manual and attach each lever, switch box, etc. to the handlebar.



- 4) Attach the bar end plug to the bar end adapter using the included M8 bolt (Fig 2).

*The bar-end adapter is designed for easy attachment of hand guards and other accessories. Please refer to our website for details.



- 5) Turn the steering wheel slowly to the left and right, check that the throttle rotates smoothly, and check that there are no obstacles to steering operation by applying load to each wire and hose.

*If the grip rubber contacts the handle and throttle movement is not smooth, cut the grip rubber.

4.Notes on Use

Periodically inspect the following

- Check for loose bar end adapters.
- Smooth rotating throttle tube.
